Introduction

Overview of the two hundred and sixty-six Popes

- 1) Six reprobate Popes who are in the eternal fire of Hell, namely:
- ❖ Clement V
- ❖ Clement VI
- ❖ Alexander VI
- ❖ Leo X
- A Paul IV
- * and Clement XIV,
- who in their Pontificates, though they were perverse and abominable in God's eyes, nonetheless never erred when solemnly teaching the Church in accord with their Office as Universal Doctor.
- 2) One Venerable Expiator Pope, namely Boniface VII, who is in Purgatory which he shall leave at Christ's Return to earth to establish His Messianic Kingdom of peace. This Venerable Expiator is the only Pope who was antipope prior to becoming Pope.
- 3) Two hundred and fifty-eight Blessed Popes; of whom one hundred and ten expiated their faults and failings in Purgatory.
- 4) One Pope happily reigning.
- 5) Of the two hundred and sixty-six Popes, only one resigned, namely Saint Celestine V.
- 6) During their respective Pontificates, the first seventeen Popes were Superior-Generals of the Order of Essenes or of Mount Carmel by automatic succession.
- 7) Throughout the history of Christ's Holy Church, all the Popes, including the six reprobates and the Venerable Expiator, at all times vigorously opposed the abolition of Sacrosanct Priestly Celibacy.
- 8) In parallel with the Pontificates of the Popes who have shepherded Christ's Holy Church, down through the centuries there have been more than one hundred antipopes who sowed cockle all about.

Apostle of Papal Supremacy in spiritual and temporal orders; of Papal Infallibility, of the lifelong character of the Pope's exercise of Office, of the Pope's Power to choose his successor; of the Holy Sacrifice of Mass, Sublime Unbloody Perpetuation of the Bloody Sacrifice of the Cross of Calvary; of the Sublime Saving Work of Reparation and Redemption carried out by Christ and Mary on the Cross of Calvary perpetuated in the Holy Sacrifice of Mass; of Eucharistic Worship; of the efficacy of the Seven Holy Sacraments instituted by Our Lord Jesus Christ for Holy Mother Church to administer; of the efficacy of the Holy Sacrament of the Papacy or Eighth Sacrament, Sublime Key to the Seven Holy Sacraments; of the Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity; of the Divinity of the Word, of the Divinity of the Holy Spirit; of Two Natures in Christ, of the Holy Face, of the Triumphant Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ, of His Admirable Ascension into Heaven, of His permanent assistance to the Church, of His spiritual presence in the midst of two or more gathered together in His Name, of His Return with great majesty and glory accompanied by His myriads of Angels to judge the living and the dead and establish His Messianic Kingdom of peace on earth; of Mary's Immaculate Conception, of Her Perpetual Virginity, of Her Divine Maternity, of Her Immortality and of Her Gentle Dormition; of the Most Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary Transpierced on Calvary giving birth to the Church; of the Sacred Family, Model of Christian families; of Saint Joseph's Perpetual Virginity, of the existence of original sin, of the need for Prayer; of the seven Holy Archangels, of the Holy Patriarchs of the Old Testament; of the Holy Sacramentals of the Church, of the Holiness of the Christian Family, of Christian decency in dress, of the particular judgement of each human being following death; of singing in Divine Worship, of decorum in everything pertaining to Divine Worship; of the Holy Shroud, of the True Cross of Redemption of Our Lord Jesus Christ and fixed to it the Holy INRI and Sacred Nails which pierced the Hands and Feet of Our Redeemer; of the Lord's Sacred Crown of Thorns, and of Worship of Sacred Relics and Imágenes. Fiery Lover of Christ's Passion. Renowned Defender of Mary's Co-Redemptory Mission and of Her Universal Co-Mediation. Flaming Sword against simoniacs. Exalted Whip against nicholites, apostate jews, nazarians, ananiasites, aristobulites, acephalous, iconoclasts and other heretics. Signal Chanter of the Glories and Prerogatives of Mary and Joseph. Sublime Preacher of Mary Irredeemed Assumed into Heaven in

Body and Soul, and of quasi-Immaculate Joseph Assumed into Heaven in Body and Soul. Most Illustrious Consul of God. Guarantor of Sound Doctrine. Zealous Guardian of the Lord's House. Dread of liars. Great Exhorter of fear of Hellfire's eternal pains. Loving and Magnanimous Pardoner of repentant sinners and apostates. Teacher, Doctor and Guide of the Apostolic College. Unbreachable Watchtower over Catholic Orthodoxy. Citadel of holy and wise counsels. *This Most Glorious Pope solemnly opened, presided over, directed, approved and solemnly closed the three Holy Dogmatic Councils of Jerusalem.* Lover of Justice and Hater of iniquity. Model of perseverance until death in the mission given by God even in the midst of great vicissitudes. Example of Undaunted Fighter when hemmed in by the enemy. Abnegated Benefiter of the sick and aged. Stay of widows and orphans. Father of the poor and Solace of the afflicted. Most Ardent and Fecund Solar Luminary of the Church. He rose on Resurrection Sunday of the year 1034.

One of the 72 official Disciples. Chosen by Christ on Palm Sunday of the year 34. Confirmed in the Faith on glorious Pentecost Sunday. Born in Volterra, Pisa, Italy. Pontificate: from 29-6-67 to 23-9-76. Great Mystic. Stigmatic. Vilely calumniated by order of antipope Nazarius II. Martyr. Died decapitated. Apostle of Papal Supremacy in spiritual and temporal orders; of Peter's efficacious Primacy; of the Most Holy Trinity; of the Excellences of Our Lord Jesus Christ, true God and true Man; of the Glories and Prerogatives of the Divine Mary and of Joseph Most Holy, of Archangel Saint Gabriel, of Apostles Saint Peter and Saint Paul; of Worship of the Lord's Sacred Relics, and of Worship of Sacred Relics and *Imágenes*. Exalted Whip against multiple heretics. Eminent Exalter of the Sublime Salvific action of the Holy Sacrifice of Mass and of the great spiritual benefits of the Holy Sacrament of Communion. Chanter of the great spiritual benefits of the Holy Sacrament of Confession. He rose on Easter Sunday of the year 1034.

Chapter III

3. Saint Cletus the Great

One of the 72 official Disciples. Chosen by Christ on Palm Sunday of the year 34. Confirmed in the Faith on glorious Pentecost Sunday. Born in Rome, Italy. Pontificate: from 23-9-76 to 26-4-88. Great Mystic. Stigmatic. Vilely calumniated by order of antipopes Nazarius II and Macarius. Martyr. Died decapitated. Apostle of Papal Supremacy in spiritual and temporal orders; of the Most Holy Trinity; of the Eternal Father given infinite Reparation by Christ and Mary, of the Excellences of Our Lord Jesus Christ, true God and true Man; and of the Holy Spirit, Dweller in the souls of the righteous; of the Glories and Prerogatives of the Divine Mary and of Joseph Most Holy; of Worship of the Lord's Sacred Relics, and of Worship of Sacred Relics and *Imágenes*. Exalted Whip against macarians and other multiple heretics. Prestigious Exalter of the Holy Sacrifice of Mass, Sublime Unbloody Perpetuation of the Bloody Sacrifice of the Cross of Calvary. Renowned Chanter of the great spiritual benefits of the Holy Sacrament of Communion. Sublime Preacher of the

excellence of the Holy Sacrament of Priestly Order and of the Holy Sacrament of Confirmation. He rose on Easter Sunday of the year 1034.

Chapter IV

4. Saint Clement I the Great

One of the 72 official Disciples. Chosen by Christ on Palm Sunday of the year 34. Confirmed in the Faith on glorious Pentecost Sunday. Born in Rome, Italy. Pontificate: from 26-4-88 to 23-11-97. Great Mystic. Stigmatic. Vilely calumniated by order of antipopes Macarius and Ananias II. Martyr. Died thrown into the sea with an anchor tied about his neck. Apostle of Papal Supremacy in spiritual and temporal orders; of the Most Holy Trinity; of the Excellences of Our Lord Jesus Christ, true God and true Man; of the Glories and Prerogatives of the Divine Mary and Joseph Most Holy, of Worship of the Lord's Sacred Relics, and of Worship of Sacred Relics and Imágenes. Exalted Whip against ananiasites and other multiple heretics. Majestic Consul of God. Champion of Christian Unity. Eminent Exhorter of fear of Hellfire's eternal pains. Comforting Watchtower over Catholic Orthodoxy. Eminent Exalter of the Sublime Saving Work of Reparation and Redemption carried out by Christ and Mary on the Cross of Calvary perpetuated in the Holy Sacrifice of Mass. Signal Chanter of the spiritual fortification of the Holy Sacrament of Confirmation as continuative action of the great spiritual benefits of the Holy Sacrament of Baptism. Apostle of Papal Supremacy in spiritual and temporal orders; of the Most Holy Trinity; of the Excellences of Our Lord Jesus Christ, true God and true Man; of the Passion, Death and Triumphant Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ; of the Holy Spirit, the Great Supernatural Gift; of Mary's Co-Redemptory Mission and of Her Universal Co-Mediation; of the Glories and Prerogatives of the Divine Mary and Joseph Most Holy; of the Lord's Holy Apostles and Disciples; of Worship of the Lord's Sacred Relics, and of Worship of Sacred Relics and Imágenes. Exalted Whip against demetrians and other multiple heretics. Apostle of Papal Supremacy in spiritual and temporal orders; of the Most Holy Trinity; of the Excellences of Our Lord Jesus Christ, true God and true Man; of the Holy Spirit Septiform restoring the soul; of the Glories and Prerogatives of the Divine Mary and of Joseph Most Holy; of Sound Doctrine; of Worship of the Lord's Sacred Relics, and of Worship of Sacred Relics and *Imágenes*. Exalted Whip against sabellians and other multiple heretics. Exalted Whip against multiple heretics. Chanter of the excellences of the Holy Sacrifice of Mass, Sublime Dispenser of graces.

Chapter XVIII

18. Saint Pontian

Apostle of Papal Supremacy in spiritual and temporal orders; of the Most Holy Trinity; of the Excellences of Our Lord Jesus Christ, true God and true Man; of the Holy Spirit, Renewer of the face of the earth; of the Glories and Prerogatives of the Divine Mary and of Joseph Most Holy; of Holy Guardian Angels; of Worship of the Lord's Sacred Relics, and of Worship of Sacred Relics and *Imágenes*. Exalted Whip against multiple heretics.

Chapter XIX

19. Saint Anterus

Born in Thessalonica, Greece. Pontificate: from 1-10-235 to 3-1-236. Mystic. Vilely calumniated by order of antipope Hippolytus. Martyr. Died pierced through with arrows. Apostle of Papal Supremacy in spiritual and temporal orders; of the Most Holy Trinity; of the Excellences of Our Lord Jesus Christ, true God and true Man; of the Holy Spirit, Transformer of the Soul; of the Glories and Prerogatives of the

Divine Mary and of Joseph Most Holy; of the Sacrosanct Catholic Faith; of compilation of the Martyrs' Records; of Worship of the Lord's Sacred Relics, and of Worship of Sacred Relics and *Imágenes*. Exalted Whip against multiple heretics. Zealous Guardian of Sacrosanct Priestly Celibacy, and of the Holiness of Christian Marriage. Chanter of the excellences of the Holy Sacrifice of Mass, Sublime Ark of the Covenant.

Chapter XX

20. Saint Fabian the Great

Born in Rome, Italy. Pontificate: from 10-1-236 to 20-1-250. Great Mystic. Stigmatic. Vilely calumniated by order of antipopes Hippolytus and Linus II. Martyr. Died devoured by lions.
